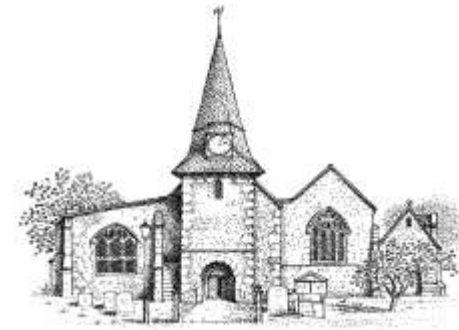

Next Steps for Parishes in the Western Wards of Fareham

Our acting Archdeacon, Will Hughes, met with the PCC on 12 January. He was joined by Victoria James, the Diocesan Secretary and all our PCC members. Similar meetings were held that same week with St John's Locks Heath and St Paul's Sarisbury.

Will reported that considerable time had been taken to gather information from across the Diocese through meetings and Deanery Plans, so the Archdeacons and Diocesan Senior Staff are now in a position to draw up proposals for the allocation of stipends. Fareham Deanery, and the Western Wards in particular, is the first area to be addressed. At least three meetings will be held with the Archdeacon to discuss proposals for filling the three local vacancies. Churchwardens and PCC Secretaries from all three parishes will represent their churches and where an individual from any parish is unable to attend another nominated representative can take their place. It has been requested that St Mary's, Hook with Warsash might also be represented at these meetings. After each meeting churchwardens will report back to their own PCC and information will be shared when there is progress to report.

Minutes of the meeting with the Archdeacon on 12 January will be available in church shortly.

The PCC is an elected body that represents all of us at St Peter's, so please feel free to share thoughts or questions with any individual member.
