

REPORTING A SAFEGUARDING CONCERN

If you have information about a safeguarding situation where a child or adult is in **immediate** danger, or requires immediate attention, call emergency services on 999.

Any safeguarding concerns should be reported to your Parish Safeguarding Officer (PSO) and/or Incumbent as soon as possible. The flowchart below illustrates the process for responding to safeguarding concerns or incidents.
